The water park and whirlpool resurfacing project was done in the Spring of 2023 due to safety concerns. To open the water park on Memorial Day of 2023 the project needed to be completed so that we could provide a safe area for our members and guests. The concrete surface was wearing thin and breaking up which inturn caused a rough surface that was unsafe for swimmers. The surface was unsafe because it was leading to users getting scratches and cuts due to the roughness of the concrete at the bottom of the water park. The surface had the feel of sandpaper.
