Chapman Cultural Center was built in 2007 and has been a game changer for our community as it is one of the few Local Arts Agencies in the country that includes arts and sciences in one space. We have reached our 15th anniversary, and as we are looking forward to the future, we are reimagining our building and grounds to accommodate the evolving needs of our community. As a community space that has welcomed over 3 million visitors since opening, the purpose of our request is to ensure that visitors and residents of our community can access our campus safely and easily. Visibility is an important focus of this project for this reason as updated signage, new lighting, and an exterior wash would greatly benefit our Visitor Experience, as well as make the campus easier to navigate. This ties into our second focus of reinvigorating our space--Safety. Without proper lighting and signage, concerns have arisen regarding the safety of our patrons, many of which are children, as they navigate our campus for various classes, programs, and exhibits. We want to ensure the safety of parents visiting campus and dropping off their children, as well as staff staying after hours.

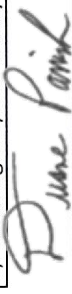
