Everyone from artists to our supporters to every person who has rallied around art in Lake City has helped put southern art on the map, has made art more accessible, and has given ArtFields and Lake City and impact far beyond its small town roots. The state's funding for our ArtFields programming will allow us to significantly grow and enhance our audience and impact: 1- Programming will continue to *Lift Up Lake City* in a meaningful way.

ArtFields will continue to support and enrich the lives of the people who first rallied around art and made ArtFields possible, the people who call Lake City home. Art has become and continues to be an economic driver for the city. Additionally, each year our youth programming directly impacts 10K+ area students. With state funding we can significantly increase that number. 2- We will continue to *Celebrate Southern Art* with an emphasis on increasing artists opportunities and improving the competition experience for artists and visitors. 3- We will *Grow our Year Round Art Town* programming and experience which will directly impact the public. ArtFields will continue to foster an environment conducive to artistic expression and growth, making lake City a place where artists want to work and live. Our Artist Studios and Artist in Residency program, in particular, will be a huge benefit to the residents of Lake City, bringing additional programming and expertise to the area.
