Please explain how these funds will be used to provide a public benefit:

Funding will be utilized to prevent water hazards that currently exist at the 96 Visitor Center. Water runoff from Hwy 34 builds up into the parking lot. The current drainage system is broken and inadequate. The sidewalk was cut to alleviate and displace water, but has created a stepping hazard. Removal of the broken curbing will prevent falls. The newly installed handicap ramp will provide access to the front of the building from the side. Currently the only handicapped ramp is in the front, creating a safety hazard as people have to go out into the roadway to go around the broken curbing. The funding will correct the previous erroneous design for the greater good of the public.
