

Description	Budget	Explanation
Construction of a new male/female restroom facility at the Southern end of Mishoe Park adjacent to the south side of the Greeleyville Town Hall and the Greeleyville Town Centre.	\$100,000.00	Construction of 7 women's stalls and three men's stalls and 2-3 urinals in the respective bathrooms with two ADA-compliant stalls in the ladies' room and one ADA-compliant in the men's room.
Purchase and installation of the Pearl Whack Park and Baseball Field Lighting	\$100,000.00	The lighting system is important but of secondary priority for the Town, given the need for a restroom facility in the Town Centre. Once everything is finalized, we will complete this portion of the \$400,000 project, which is, approximately \$300,000 and we currently have \$365,000 identified for the total project resulting in a shortfall of \$35,000.

Please explain how these funds will be used to provide a public benefit:

Primary is the completion of the Mishoe Park restroom facility, which will be available to everyone around and near the park and Town Centre. Generally, to make essential and beneficial improvements at the two Town of Greeleyville Parks. Williamsburg County owns Pearl Whack, but the Town is currently negotiating a 30-year lease prior to the completion of the lighting improvements. The Town of Greeleyville owns Mishoe Park.




