Please explain how these funds will be used to provide a public benefit:

Our mission is to combat hunger, loneliness, and isolation on those citizens living in Pickens County and to provide a lifeline through the use of caring volunteers. We are able to reach our mission through our two programs - home delivered meals to homebound seniors and the Young at Heart senior center programs. PCMOW is working with our community partner, YMCA of Easley, to open a third Young at Heart senior center. The YMCA is constructing a new facility that is adjacent to their existing building. The existing building will be renovated to accommodate a child development center and PCMOW's Young at Heart senior center. Funds received will be spent on the renovation of the senior center portion. The total project is anticipated to be \$800,000. Our goal is to be open by the end of year 2024. PCMOW's Young at Heart senior centers in Liberty and Central have over 100 members combined. Each weekday we serve at least 60 seniors between the two centers. The Young at Heart senior center is open to anyone who is age 55 and up. The Easley Young at Heart center is expected to serve more seniors than the existing two sites. The city of Easley has the largest population of citizens within Pickens County. We feel that the Young at Heart senior center in Easley is overdue and we are excited to be able to offer a place for aging adults to improve or maintain their quality of life.


