Description	Budget	Explanation
Maintenance/Equipment Shed for Allison Creek Park	\$30,000.00	More space is needed to store equipment and maintenance related items for operations of the park
Improvements to Ebenezer Park	\$510,000.00	Phase 2 Renovations are planned for Ebenezer Park to address some 20-30 year old structures in the park (rebuild and renovate) and utility infrastructure, replacing old playground equipment with new, and additional enhancements that are necessary to the park operations.
Shade Structure for Playground at Field Day Park	\$400,000.00	This playground is one of our highly used playgrounds in the County and has very limited shade from tree canopy.
Batting Cage for Field Day Park	\$50,000.00	There are three diamond fields and only two batting cages. Adding an additional cage will provide a warm-up cage for each field and surrounding park users safety by having designated warm up areas.
New Monument for Veteran's Park	\$10,000.00	These funds are to be used to purchase and install a new monument.
Grand Total	\$1,000,000.00	

Please explain how these funds will be used to provide a public benefit:

These funds will be used to provide improvements to our existing parks and provide great benefit to all park users. Safety is a priority within our park systems and is the reasoning behind majority of these requests. Allison Creek Park is a newly acquired park that is 160 acres. Additional maintenance equipment was needed to best monitor the park and respond to emergencies in a timely manner, therefore, the additional shed is needed to store the equipment. Ebenezer Park users will have a very much improved experience with the new restrooms and bathroom

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facilities, playground, campground infrastructure and many other park enhancements. Specifically, the restrooms are designed to be family-friendly and meet the needs of all park users. Field Day Park has experienced concerns of no shade for the playground as well as barriers to help with foul balls as the playground sits near three diamond fields. Safety netting has already been installed to alleviate this, but a shade structure will add more safety not just from foul balls, but also the sun as it is our most used playground, year-round. In addition to the shade structure, with the addition of a third batting cage, all three fields will have adequate and equal warming up areas that is safe for the park users and spectators. Lastly, the new monument is to honor veterans from the American Revolutionary War and will be the first of its kind installed at the Veteran's Park.
