



Final Project Summary: North Augusta Miracle League Field.

Since 2002, The RECing Crew has been providing leisure and recreational choices for individuals with disabilities throughout the CSRA. In 2023, we served over 6000+ in attendance at one or more of the 16 leisure and recreational programs that are currently offered.

During the past twenty-two years, we have always envisioned a playing field that would be accessible and safe while offering our players inclusion in their community. On June 21, 2021, the City of North Augusta passed a resolution allowing The RECing Crew to build a Miracle League Field within the baseball complex at Riverview Park.

A 'Miracle Field' is an inclusive, universally accessible, soft-surface baseball diamond created especially for athletes with disabilities. The field allows players to enjoy themselves without barriers or obstacles. The surface also accommodates wheelchairs and other assistive devices while helping to prevent possible injuries. This field will bring the opportunity for those with disabilities to play baseball regardless of their abilities.

The North Augusta Miracle League (NAML) Field is designed as a multipurpose field with 2 baseball diamonds and a soccer field. It has been built in the Riverview Baseball Complex in North Augusta making it visible in the community. In addition to the field being used for baseball, the North Augusta Miracle League is designed to be a multipurpose facility where other therapeutic activities such as tournaments, kickball, pickleball, movie nights, and more can be held. The RECing Crew is partnering with other agencies that provide services to children and adults with disabilities within our community to offer them the use of the field for their special programs, outdoor activities, classroom programs, and more.

This field is already achieving:

- Opportunity for those with and without disabilities to play sports, regardless of their abilities inclusively within the North Augusta Baseball Complex at Riverview Park
- Visibility in the COMMUNITY = Acceptance and less Isolation
- Addition of NEW programs within the community
