The project was approved to be on the ballot by a selection committee and if the referendum passes in November 2024, The Town of Ware Shoals will receive funding as early as April 2025. The landscape architect felt that with the possible addition on the concession/restroom facility that we should wait to install the sidewalks upon completion of the facility. He stated that it would be a cleaner project. If the referendum does not pass, We will be able to complete the project by March 2025.
