These funds will be utilized to connect the existing Mary H Wright Greenway with the historic Spartanburg Old City Cemetery. This connection will extend the Greenway and promote its usage as a sustainable transportation alternative. Extending the Greenway will provide residents and visitors with additional recreation opportunities, promoting health and physical activity. Funds will also be utilized for improvements to the Cemetery, including landscape improvements and the repavement of its entrances. These beautification efforts will not only provide benefit to the residents immediately surrounding the Cemetery, but will also promote visitation to the historic site itself.
