Byerly Park is the City of Hartsville's largest recreational park within the city limits serving both city and county residents. The park consists of an indoor gym, outdoor basketball court, tennis courts, football fields, baseball/softball fields, playground equipment, dog park, and outdoor walking trail. The outdoor walking trail has not been resurfaced or repaired in many years with some areas posing safety hazard for pedestrians. Correcting these areas would increase safety to users and mitigate trip hazards.
