## Please explain how these funds will be used to provide a public benefit:

The Mount Pleasant Way project is a town wide network of connected shared-use paths intended for non-motorized users that will link key portions of the Town including recreation facitilities, parks, schools, neighborhoods, and commercial zones. The intent of this network is to provide safe and efficient infrastructure for alternative modes of transportation for our residents and visitors to use for both recreation and communiting purposes. The funding will support the construction of almost two miles of shared use path along Mathis Ferry Road, a scenic highway running parallel to US Highway 17. Phase 1 design is near completion and has included collaboration with the historic Scanlonville Settlement Community and all adjacent property owners. The Phase 2 route includes Lucy Beckham High School, the Mount Pleasant branch of the Charleston County Library, and multiple neighborhoods including the historic Green Hill settlement community. Phase 2 is funded through a 2023 Safe Streets & Roads for All (SS4A) grant for design and construction. Additionally, Charleston County Greenbelt funds have been secured for any right-of-way or recreational easements required to accommodate the path design along Mathis Ferry Rd.
