### Please explain how these funds will be used to provide a public benefit:

This project consists of a multijurisdictional partnership to develop a multiuse path linking Conway and Myrtle Beach. The long-term goal of this joint partnership among the City of Myrtle Beach, City of Conway, and Horry County is to construct a trail dedicated to non-motorized uses, primarily for bicycle and pedestrian applications. The overall project is divided into three portions with each jurisdiction responsible for a segment of the trail. The City of Conway's section runs from the Waccamaw River to Carolina Forest Boulevard. Horry County's portion runs from Carolina Forest Boulevard to George Bishop Parkway at the Intracoastal Waterway. The City of Myrtle Beach's segment connects George Bishop Parkway to the City's existing trails network at Oak Street. Horry County is planning to construct a shared use path on the east side of railroad tracks, totaling 12,305 linear feet, from the termination of an existing path network at Carolina Forest Boulevard to Christa McAuliffe Street within existing railroad rights of way, again owned by Horry County. From Christa McAuliffe Street, a 8' shared use path would run along the west side of the railroad tracks to River Oaks Drive, totaling 5,550 linear feet. From River Oaks Drive, a shared use pathway will parallel River Oaks Drive, adjacent to curbing, and continue along George Bishop Parkway and cross the Intracoastal Waterway at the Fantasy Harbour bridge for a total of 4,478 linear feet. This award will use used for design and partial construction of a portion of the pathway located in unincorporated Horry County.
