Indian Land has just a few very small parks for outdoor recreation. Indian Land Green has been able to acquire a long term lease on a 60 acre property that is bordered on one side by a significant stream. We have been spending the last three months improving parts of the land; and will continue to do so through at least the next year to create a park that will be open to use by the public. Included amenities will be several miles of nature trails, a greenway along the stream. an education center, apiaries, an open pavilion, and hopefully some soccer fields.
