Please explain how these funds will be used to provide a public benefit:

The mission of Cancer Survivors Park Alliance (CSPA) is to cultivate an environment which engages, educates, empowers, and enhances the lives of all those touched by cancer. Cancer Survivors Park (CSP) serves the State of SC, the Upstate community and truly anyone who visits as a central venue for free public access to survivorship programs and events.

The concept for this destination for hope and healing arose from the need to provide a place outside of the clinical setting for patients, their families, and friends. What began as a healing garden in 1999 evolved into a project that successfully transformed 6.8 acres of overgrown kudzu, a section of the central Reedy River, a parking lot, and sewer lines to become one of South Carolina's signature venues for reflection, gathering and celebration. The acreage that made this Park possible was donated by crucial land partners Naturaland Trust and Renewable Water Resources. Upstate Forever manages a conservation easement on portions of the land.

CSPA and its organizational partners are responsible for vital enhancements that contribute to experiences that enable the mission to come alive. Funding from the State of SC allows CSPA to complete the physical park, signage, elements and enhancements to CSP including programs and ongoing projects that are critical to helping visitors navigate its free resources to hope and healing.
