Large RV's have hit tree limbs accessing property and have zero amount of space to manuswer once inside the existing parking lot. The acquisition of property will allow for multiple large RVs, 13 vehicular parking spaces to be built on the property allowing visitors more accessibility to the center. This property extension will benefit the public by allowing secure parking, a place for the traveling public to rest in a secure location.
