Please explain how these funds will be used to provide a public benefit:

All funds requested for allocation are a specific benefit to the County and our citizens. The funding requests range a spectrum of community needs and services. 1. Fair Oak Youth Center is the only non-municipal youth recreation facility in the County, and provides rural youth sporting opportunities that would otherwise not be available to these children. 2. Wild Hearts Equine Therapy provides no or low cost therapy sessions to all ages in a serene farm setting. This is the only facility of this type in the entire county. 3. Golden Corner Food Pantry is a food distribution facility that provides fresh and shelf-stable food items both in their brick and mortar location, and through mobile services throughout the County. 4. Ebenezer Community Club provides a space for community and private meetings, hosts fundraisers for various public service organizations and is the hub of the Ebenezer community. 5. Seneca River Association is one of the oldest organizations for community services in Seneca, South Carolina. The Association provides no-cost community classes and workshops for life improvements, youth and the elderly. 6. Westminster Music Centre is a hub of community activity and fellowship on Main Street, Westminster. The facility, located in an historic and aging building, hosts main street events as well as serves as the primary family entertainment center in Westminster. 7. Oconee County Sheriff's Office provides law enforcement, victims advocacy and community outreach throughout the entire County.


