We are on a mission to introduce people of all ages and all walks of life to the timeless values that can propel ordinary individuals toward achieving the extraordinary. What sets us apart from the hundreds of other leadership efforts is we are one of only a few organizations in our Nation committed to uniting and empowering citizens with the profound values of the Medal of Honor: Courage, Integrity, Commitment, Sacrifice, Citizenship and Patriotism.

Since last year, we have been able to hire more staff and plan more leadership awareness events to attract donors and corporate sponsors. We hire Medal of Honor recipients to appear at our leadership events to speak about their experiences and their leadership values. With a new marketing and PR firm onboard, we have been able to attract more attention across the nation and gain more awareness.

Your generosity has directly supported our values-based educational programming which launched in January 2025 with a leadership program for first responders and fire fighters. We will continue more programs this summer with a week-long junior leadership program for Charleston County Jr. and Sr. high school students. This will be an intensive program designed to teach values-based leadership skills to Jr. and Sr. high school students and will continue monthly throughout the year.

Your generosity has also helped us with the design and pre-construction of the National Medal of Honor Center for Leadership to be built at Patriots Point. This will serve as the operational hub for our programming, and a destination for individuals and teams to experience our values-based leadership training.
