For the shade structure for playground at Field Day Park, we purchased and installed shade structures to cover the entire playground area. The cost of the shade structures was \$325,959. With this added feature, we are providing safe play for all by shading the playground area from the direct sun and heat. This helps keep small children safe from sun exposure as well as keep families safe while their children enjoy the playground.

For the Maintenance/Equipment Shed at Allison Creek Park, the building was purchased and installed on a concrete pad as part of the overall project. Electrical was also added to the building for the ability to charge equipment as need and for lights. This is providing a safe space to store and work on equipment that is necessary to best maintain the grounds of the park for the public to enjoy.

Park upgrades, we have completed a number of upgrades in this park over the past year to include, a new playground and traffic improvements. The old playground was over 20 years old. This playground is a inclusive playground with a pour in place surfacing and is about three times the size of the old playground. This amenity will give our park visitors an area to bring their children for endless and interactive play. This park hits capacity most weekends in the summer this causing traffic congestion along a public roadway. We built a turnaround area to allow for improved traffic flow and to minimize congestion when the park reached capacity. This allows for safer turnaround of vehicles and improves one's wait time. There are still a few improvements left to finish for Ebenezer Park for FY26.

As for the remaining project (Batting Cage) under this grant, this will be constructed in FY26.
