Maintaining a healthy dune system and a dry sand beach is essential for enhancing public access to recreational opportunities, supporting vital habitats for wildlife—including the Loggerhead Turtle—and providing a natural buffer that protects infrastructure and boosts property values.

The funds will be used to help cover the costs of several beach nourishment projects on the north and south ends of the island, where significant erosion caused by natural processes and increasingly frequent weather events is threatening shoreline stability and the long-term sustainability of the city's coastal economy.

As a proactive measure, the city is undertaking precautionary nourishment efforts in preparation for a larger-scale project scheduled for construction in Fiscal Year 2027. The timeline for completion is pending, contingent on permitting requirements.
