The funds will be used to design and construct a public roadway, enhancing connectivity between two major corridors and providing the needed access to riverfront property, providing for future taxable development opportunities. The funds being provided by the State will be matched with other public/private funds to provide a complete connection between Gervais/Senate to Blossom and from Huger to the new roadway.
