The requested funds provide the public with expanded recreation opportunities within the City of Conway, including boardwalk and nature trails, floating docks to allow for increased boat traffic, pool renovation/construction at Smith Jones, upgrades to parks including pickleball courts, and expansion of the Riverwalk from Conway's downtown area to the Waccamaw River. ***Please note: original budget for FY2016-2017 Riverwalk expansion was \$150,000. The project was completed for \$121,000 and Senator Rankin approved moving the balance of \$29,000 to FY2023-2024 Riverwalk Connection to Kingston Lake, which brings that budget from \$750,000 to \$779,000.
