The Morris College frontage will receive updated plantings as well as cameras for safety 🐧 will improve utrities through relocation and rehabilitation, as well as re ocate overhead utilities to a safer and more aesthetically appealing location and make the North Main Street Corridor safer for pedestrians and drivers alike by addressing deficient geometry and installing new sidewalks and curbs where none currently exist. This project also has local funding in the amount of \$5,000,000 and Federal funding in the amount of \$11,400,000.
