WHEREAS, the municipality of York, S. C.
is incorporated under the laws of the State of South Carolina;

AND WHEREAS, a charter has been issued to the above municipality of
York, S. C. (5-17-1900)

AND WHEREAS, Section 47-20 of the 1962 Code of Laws, as amended,
requires that all municipalities to adopt a specific form of government.

AND WHEREAS, an ordinance was filed with the Secretary of State on
October 6, 1975, setting forth;

FIRST: The name of the municipality is City of York, S. C.

SECOND: The form of government adopted is Council-Manager
form of government.

NOW THEREFORE, I, O. Frank Thornton, Secretary of State, by virtue
of authority vested in me by section 47-22 of the 1962 Code, as amended,
do hereby issue to the municipality of York, S. C.
this Certificate of Incorporation with the privileges, powers and
immunities, and subject to the limitations prescribed in Act. No. 283 of
1975.
