Cypress Engineering, 30% Design Development	\$31,217.63	This funding will be used for payment of a portion of the expenses for this phase of construction which will include the 30% Design Development and Early Site Package Drawings. (A remaining \$75,000 will be paid from separate earmarked funds.)
GPA Land Surveying (TOPO survey)	\$19,500.00	This funding will pay for a TOPO survey for the proposed site of the new facility.
Compass Five Partners, LLC	\$158,670.00	Funding will be used to develop and deliver design development drawings for construction.
Rogge + Associates	\$60,000.00	Funding will be used to continue developing and conducting items necessary for a successful capital fund drive.
Clarion Communications	\$28,885.00	Funding will be used to develop marketing and PR materials and a new website for DHC for use in the capital fund drive.
The Bank of South Carolina	\$79,232.37	A line of credit loan through The Bank of South Carolina.
The Bank of South Carolina	\$50,000.00	A deposit will be made into DHC's Mortgage Interest Account at the Bank of South Carolina to pay interest on the purchase loan for the property for the new facility.
DHC Operating Budget	\$60,795.00	DHC will increase its staff from 1 FT & 2 PT employees to 2 FT & 2 PT employees to meet increased workloads associated with the capital fund drive and in preparation for the new facility.
Gilbert & Lee Construction	\$11,700.00	Funding will pay for completed pre-construction items to include reviewing construction documents, determining material availability & coordinating the overall project layout for construction.


