Many children do not have enough food to keep them nourished especially on weekends when there are no school lunches. One in nine South Carolinians are food challenged and one in seven of those are children. We will provide 35,000 venison meat sticks to backpack programs in South Carolina this year. One in nine South Carolinians are food challenged according to Feeding America. We will supply over 37,000 lbs. Of venison to nonprofits in South Carolina. One pound of venison makes 5 meals. Adults and children who are food challenged will benefit from our program.
