## Please explain how these funds will be used to provide a public benefit:

The Saluda Grade Rail trail will run along an inactive Norfolk Sourthern line extending from Inman, SC to Zirconia, NC. In total, the trail corridor is 31 miles long, with 16 miles in South Carolina and 15 miles in North Carolina. These funds will serve as partial funding for the acqusition of the rail line from Inman to the North Carolina border. Partners in North Carolina will be responsible for assembling the funding needed for their portion of the corridor. The Saluda Grade Rail Trail will greatly enhance residents' access to trails, improve opportunities for a better quality of life and health outcomes for residents, and will have notable impact on economic development opportunities from Inman to Landrum. Additionally, by partnering with organizations in North Carolina, this trail will provide South Carolina residents and visitors with access to the historic Saluda Grade, the steepest standard gauge mainline railroad ever built in the United States. The South Carolina portion of the project is being done in partnership with Play Advocate Live Well (PAL), Upstate Forever, and Conserving Carolina.
