The primary purpose of this proposal is New Trail Construction. The funds will build a rubberized track on the Sandy Run Community Park property in Gaston, SC. The track will be a 0.25 mile loop on the north side of the parking lot on the west side of Highway 21. This project will be the first public walking tack in this area of Calhoun County. This walking track will encourage more residents and visitors to visit the park, driving more traffic to local businesses in the Sandy Run area and stimulating the local economy. Finally, this project is in direct response to feedback collected at a public input meetings.
