Funds will support FY23 general operating costs of Spoleto Festival USA to maintain and expand its significant community support through a multidiscplinary performing arts Festival slated to take place May 26-June 11, 2023. For 17 days and nights each spring, Spoleto Festival USA fills Charleston, South Carolina's historic theaters, churches, and outdoor spaces with over 100 performances by renowned artists as well as emerging performers in opera; theater; dance; and chamber, symphonic, choral, and jazz music. The Festival's mission is to present programs of the highest artistic caliber while maintaining a dedication to young artists, a commitment to all forms of the performing arts, a passion for contemporary innovation, and an enthusiasm for providing unusual performance opportunities for established artists. Each season, the Festival employs more than 500 full-time, part-time, and seasonal staffers, including 80 musicians for the Spoleto Festival USA Orchestra and 60 apprentices in arts administration and production. Spoleto Festival USA was founded with a mission to pair young artists with established masters and provide a fertile ground for experimentation, exploration, and artistic learning. This vision, however, extends far beyond the concert stages and opera houses. Vital to the Festival's longevity are its endeavors to engage the community across a broad spectrum. Through three distinct avenues—community engagement, programs for professional advancement, and tailored education programs—Spoleto ETC (Engaging the Community) aims to build audiences, spark connections, and leave a lasting impression on the next generation of artists and arts lovers. The Festival serves the public as a cultural hub, bringing diverse artists and performances for the community to experience and engage with each season.
