Please explain how these funds will be used to provide a public benefit:

(1.) The request for funds (earmark) is to help with the completion of the new, currently under construction, concrete pier. Our town citizens have planned for and supported the construction of this pier for the last 6 years. While the project is moving forward, the cost for materials, our ability to receive materials, our ability to change materials when no longer available, the increased amount of time to receive materials, and the cost of labor, have all increased the cost of completing the project. (2.) The pier is an anchor for economic development and tourism for the Town of Surfside Beach and surrounding local region. The pier will support a restaurant, entertainment area, and a small retail store. This project is supported by the Myrtle Beach Area Chamber of Commerce as they understand the benefit to the whole region. (3.) The cost of the pier has increased by over \$5,000,000 since the original budget. (4.) Anticipation of the pier completion has already generated new business opportunities within our adjacent entertainment district.
